Hello and welcome to LETR WA 2022!

We are excited to be sharing details of the year ahead and an opportunity to highlight some events you may have missed!

We all acknowledge the unprecedented disruption the COVID-19 environment caused to all of our lives; and certainly to our policing priorities. It is reassuring for us all that we are now able to return to a sense of normality. For LETR WA, this will see increased opportunities for events and more importantly, engagement with athletes in Special Olympics WA. (SOWA).

Globally, over 110,000 officers participate in the Law Enforcement Torch Run to support Special Olympics. LETR officers engaged athletes through virtual connections when sports training was cancelled as it was important to connect with the athletes, who experienced even greater isolation during the pandemic. The LETR Global Virtual Torch Run shared video messages of support to SO athletes across the world. WA athlete Blake Veaney (son of Sergeant Rick Veaney) recorded his message from Kings Park to encourage athletes to join the GVTR.

The Law Enforcement Torch Run continues with the mission to raise funds and awareness for people in our communities with intellectual disabilities through our affiliation to the Special Olympics movement. Athletes have returned to sports training and are now competing in State and National Games to qualify for the SO World Summer Games in Berlin next year. A total of 87 SOWA athletes will be heading to Tasmania for the National Games in October so we wish them all the best of luck!

LETR SUPPORT SOWA ATHLETES AT STATE GAMES

The SOWA State Games were held over two days at Hale School in October. LETR President A/Assistant Commissioner Alan Morton APM led the athlete parade. Officers carried the flame of hope with SOWA athletes to light the cauldron for the opening ceremony. LETR officers supported the athletes over the weekend and observed the skills, determination and sportsmanship of the athletes.

ROG officers observed soccer matches and chatted to the soccer athletes before they played against the State Paralympics team. ROG talked about their role in policing and provided some athletes with an opportunity to kit up. The time to engage with the athletes created a lasting memory



LETR was proud to fund over 300 medals for the Games. Senior Sergeant Ross Blake presented SO athletes with medals for their achievements in basketball, athletics, soccer, swimming and bocce and many reached new goals to earn a place at the National Games.





The LETR were awarded a community partnership grant from ALCOA. LETR and ALCOA created a community event for International Day of People Disabilities (IDPWD). The athletes were excited to learn about the dolphins and marine life during the tour of the Mandurah canals. Local officers facilitated team games on the foreshore and everyone enjoyed the sausage sizzle. We will running another event later in the year so that more athletes have an opportunity to experience the dolphin cruise in Mandurah.
